Homebound Projects:

- Deliver food items
- Bible study
- Prayer meeting
- Deliver bag of toiletries/hygiene items
- Deliver cards of encouragement and/or pictures from children
- Yard work
- Clean up house
- Home repair
- Deliver wood for winter
- Install smoke alarms

Visitation to Nursing Homes/Assisted Living Facilities:

- Deliver bag of toiletries/hygiene items
- Bible study
- Prayer meeting

- Music ministry with adult and/or children's choir
- Painting of fingernails and fixing of hairstyles
- Deliver cards of encouragement and/or pictures from children
- Deliver "appreciation" packages to nurses, care-givers

Baby Shower (children's clothing and accessories):

- Participants will each bring baby items to be delivered to Little Life or families within the community
- Collect items for children – clothing, toys, games, hygiene items, coats to be delivered to group homes and children within the community

Car Check-Ups:

- Check fluid levels and tire pressures
- Car wash (exterior and interior)
- Give away free oil, car wash, etc.

Home Repair:

- Roof and porch repair
- Wheelchair ramp construction
- Interior and exterior painting
- General maintenance
- Yard work – clean out gutters, rake leaves, plant flowers, etc.
- Collect and dispose of trash
- Installation of smoke alarms

Laundromat Ministry:

- Pay for washing and drying of customers' clothing
- Share donuts and juice
- Engage in conversation
- Assist with loading and unloading of clothes from car

- Give out free detergent, fabric softener, etc.

Rest Stop Ministry/Block Party:

- Blood pressure and sugar checks with information for proper eating habits
- Distribution of bags of hygiene items
- Distribution of bags of toiletries
- Share donuts, juice, coffee, dinks, cookies, etc.
- Car check-ups
- Car wash
- Job hunting tips
- Bible study
- Games, face painting and other activities for children
- Pick up litter in the area
- Give out bibles
- Give out invitations to church

Delivery of Food, Clothing Items:

- Food items to be collected and delivered to God's Storehouse, God's Pit Crew, Homeless Shelter and foster families
- Clothing to be collected and delivered to Salvation Army, Goodwill, foster families and fire victims
- Delivery of food items to local fire and police stations
- Delivery of lunch to OIAM participants
- Delivery of local, surplus agricultural produce, such as potatoes, tomatoes, fruit baskets to those within the community
