


On Sunday, February 3rd, everyone is asked to bring at least one can of soup to help support the ministry of Grace Network. Our church goal is 50 cans. Thank

JONES SCHOLARSHIP FUND




Through the generosity of Inez and Casey Jones, assets have been set aside by Oak Level Baptist Church to provide scholarships to students attending institutions of higher
